4. VENUE

Culture Center Korundi The Main Hall

- Korundi House of Culture's Main Hall was designed to serve multiple musical performances and to host many types of event, with special attention in keeping the highest standard for delivering high quality of acoustic music.
- The hall is equipped to facilitate conferences, lectures, large educational groups, audio-visual presentations, and film screenings.
- The capacity is 340.



Culture Center Korundi The Foyer

- The foyer is a room with great acoustics. The room is suited for meetings, workshops, dinings or cocktail-events.
- The capacity of the room is 30 – 50.



Culture Center Korundi The Art Halls Y1 – Y5

- The Y art halls are located on the upper floor of the building.



Culture Center Korundi The Meeting Room

- The meeting room is intended for smaller meetings, workshops, and group work. A laptop computer and a data projector are available for the meeting room. Maximum capacity of the meeting room is 20.



- As all general promotion and introduction of member and observer cities will be kept from the main program of the conference, an expo for that purpose will be arranged in the lobby of the venue.
- Members and observers will be given the opportunity to:
 - add their video to the joint show reel
 - set out pamphlets
 - The show reel may also be played at the city center
